



PREVIOUS UPDATE: MARCH 13, 2020

Letter from the City Manager,

A local state of disaster has been declared for Tarrant County by the County Judge B. Glen Whitley due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The City of White Settlement is following protocol as recommended by Tarrant County Medical Director and MedStar in conjunction with the City's Fire Chief.

In response to this information, the City of White Settlement will be suspending community services beginning today, March 13, 2020 at 4:00 PM. These include Library services and events as well as Recreation Center services and events. Public Notary Services will discontinue during this time. The Senior Center will remain open with limited hours being from 10 AM to 1 PM. We recommend utilizing online payment services when possible.

These service suspensions and limited hours will continue for not more than seven days, unless the local state of disaster is continued or renewed by the Tarrant County Commissioners Court.

Our First Responders are equipped and trained in handling these situations. There are NO COVID-19 cases within our community. Should there be any in the future, our First Responders will be notified and will respond accordingly.
